Yesterday we talked about resting for the Lord. We as Christians get caught up on which day! Most Christians move this rest day to Sunday, or resurrection day. Jews and some dominations of Christians still use Saturday. Does this make a difference?

Exodus 20:8-11

⁸“Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. ⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns. ¹¹ For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

Remember God is a God of mercy not “letter of the law”. Six days work one day rest. Doesn’t mean is you cannot rest on day seven then you are done. It means you find another day to give to the Lord. I usually use Saturday for this. I do services on Sunday, so this works better for me. I rest a bit to recharge my batteries. I may wake up early and stay in bed. Prayer and meditation with the lord in my quiet place spending time with him. Work on these writings or sermons praying to Him all during it. But if your “down” day is a Tuesday or Wednesday then give it to the lord in your own way. Maybe you love to hike then walk and pray spending time in the great outdoors with the

Lord. Prayer and meditation during it. It looks different for all of us because God mad us all different.
