⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Each day twice a day sometimes three. This was a relationship not a church. Now, we get upset if the pastor asks us to a mid-week Bible study. How can we get to know anyone this way? Our God is a God of relationships. He wants to get to know each other and Him. To come into this time of communion.
